


WINDSOR GATE



As part of Windsor Gate, a Travel Plan has been produced, which sets out strategies to increase the level of sustainable travel and minimise the impact of development traffic on local roads and the environment. By promoting and monitoring travel taken by residents, the Travel Plan will aim to:

- Support a range of sustainable transport alternatives to provide the residents with options for sustainable travel to and from the site.
- Develop an awareness of the options for sustainable travel to and from the site and local area amongst residents.
- Promote car sharing, walking, cycling and public transport as safe, efficient, affordable alternatives to private cars and highlight the health and environmental benefits of using sustainable travel modes.
- Minimise the impact of car-based travel to the site on the local and strategic highway network and environment.


WALKING AND CYCLING

Windsor Gate is surrounded by a number of walking and cycling routes providing access to destinations nearby and the rest of the borough.

A section of the National Cycle Route 4 loosely follows the River Thames. It is also known as the Thames Valley Cycle Route and passes through Windsor Great Park. National Route 61 also starts near Maidenhead and follows the Jubilee River until the edge of London.


CAR SHARING

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

BUS TRAVEL

Windsor Gate is nearby to bus stops on Ruddlesway, 55m to the south of the A308, as well as on Dedworth Road. At the time of printing, the following services are provided at these stops:

Dedworth Road

 16A – St Marks Hospital to Windsor via Maidenhead, Bray, Holyport (Monday – Saturday)

Ruddlesway (South of Roundabout)

 16 – St Marks Hospital to Windsor via Maidenhead, Bray, Holyport and Dedworth (Monday – Sunday)

- W1 Windsor via Clewer & Dedworth (Monday Friday)
- 16A Windsor via Clewer & Dedworth (Monday Saturday)

Ruddlesway (opposite Martins Close)

 2 – Slough to Dedworth via Windsor (Monday – Saturday)

RAIL TRAVEL

The nearest railway station is Windsor and Eton Railway Station and is located approximately 3.3km to the east of the site. Windsor is the terminus of a branch line from Slough, and trips to central London can be made in less than an hour via the Elizabeth Line from Slough Station. SCHOOL TRAVEL

Homer First School

Homer First School is located to the southeast of the development on Testwood Road and can be accessed via foot or cycle in less than 15 minutes via Ruddlesway.

Alexander First School

Alexander First School is located south of the development on Kenneally. Cross Dedsworth Road at the pelican crossing, and continue south via footpaths until you reach the school.

Dedworth Middle School, Dedworth Green First School and Nursery

Dedworth Middle School, Dedworth Green First School and it's associated nursery are located to the south east of the site on Smiths Lane. The schools are accessible via foot or cycle, or alternatively via the W1 bus service from Ruddlesway Roundabout.


Hill Top First School

Hill Top First School is located to the south east of the site on Clewer Hill Road. The school is accessible via foot or cycle, or alternatively via the W1 bus service from Ruddlesway Roundabout.

St Edwards First and Middle School

St Edwards First and Middle Schools are located to the east of the site on Parsonage Lane. The school is accessible via foot or cycle, or alternatively via the W1 bus service from Ruddlesway Roundabout.

MONITORING REPORTS & SURVEY

As part of the Travel Plan, Windsor Gate is required to monitor the uptake of sustainable travel over a 5-year period. This monitoring will inform the success against the targets which are to be agreed with RBWM.

Monitoring will be in the form of questionnaire surveys throughout the monitoring period. These surveys will determine the level of different forms of travel undertaken by residents and will help understand any barriers to particular types of travel. The results from these monitoring surveys will be reviewed and monitoring reports will be produced to understand the effectiveness of the Travel Plan which allow for any changes to be made.

The results of the surveys and the monitoring reports will be uploaded to the website.
